Contemporary Concepts is designed to feature a wide variety of big bands and mid-size ensembles that have defined the west coast big band sound from the 1950s to the present. In addition to the 13 world class ensembles that will be performing over the four day period, we are also presenting 4 of the top University Jazz ensembles in Southern California. Each day a different University band will perform a special pool side lunch concert. In all that adds up to 17 bands featuring close to 300 musicians. As always, each day will be filled with concerts, films, panel discussions and a memorabilia trading area.






