

In addition to the original composers conducting their own works, we are also featuring works by Shorty Rogers, Marty Paich, Stan Kenton and Johnny Richards.


The Los Angeles Neophonic inspired two other significant Orchestras:

To top it all off, we will once again feature 3 University Big Bands plus the High School Jazz America Ensemble.




